<p>Playground Measurements and equipment indicative costs</p>	<p>No measurements have been forthcoming from Fife Council to date, so decided to measure playground to enable us to move forward with positioning pieces of equipment.</p> <p>Early cost indications for a stage are between £2500 and £3000, and for a shelter between £2500 and £6500. A traverse climbing wall costs between £1300 and £3700. The trim trail and a MUGA are difficult to price without specifications.</p> <p>COMIS project has not yet been allocated a contact person from FC Property Services.</p> <p>We will need a site survey and plan from FC in due course.</p>	<p>VR to speak with Chris Torrance re plans and measurements, before group makes rough plan</p> <p>JH to chase please</p>
<p>Evaluate which pieces of playground equipment work best at St. Mary's Primary, Lochee</p>	<p>St. Mary's has a trim trail and a climbing frame in a playground which was very similar to that at Tayport.</p>	<p>JH to organise visit ASAP with 2 reps each from school eco ctee and pupil council.</p>
<p>Cash for Kids funding</p>	<p>SR had applied for £5000. Now needs to specify what this is for, a decision will be made by 31.1.14.</p> <p>Decided to request money for:</p> <p>11 planters, one per class, as suggested by the school eco committee. (recycled plastic, 700mmx700mmx3500mm similar to those opposite Willisons garage).</p>	<p>SR</p> <p>VR to find out if Julie Redman (PLANT) is still willing to help with school gardening.</p>
